





### Job openings in public education began to outpace hires prior to the pandemic, although the gap has widened since March 2020.





Quits have accounted for more departures from public education than other separations and layoffs and discharges for over a decade, with only a few exceptions.


#### Teacher preparation enrollments and completions were lower in 2019-2020 than a decade ago.
